



Orange County Go Swerve Driving School. Student Lesson Policies

Student lessons are conducted behind the wheel in 90 minute sessions, except the one hour course.

One hour course	\$85.00
Two hour course	\$150.00
Four hour course	\$280.00
six hour course	\$360.00
Ten hour course	\$600.00

For use of the Go swerve vehicle during road test \$129.00 (this includes an overall 45 min review with the instructor first)

Re-test \$99 without 45 min review practice .

All lessons and lesson packages must be prepaid in full. We take most major credit and debit cards.

Cancellation of a portion of a prepaid lesson package will result in a \$25 processing fee, and pricing will revert to the pricing available for the number of lessons actually completed.

You must have a valid FL permit or current license from another state or country on your person for all lessons. You are not permitted to drive without one.

We offer lessons 7 days per week, at different times during the day. Availability varies according to instructor schedules, however we will work with you to schedule the most convenient times. We frequently schedule with different instructors, please let us know if you prefer to work with the same person.

Every individual is different, and people learn at different speeds. Your instructor will conduct a skills assessment during your first lesson, and he/she will be able to estimate the number of lessons needed at that time.



CANCELLATION POLICY: Any cancellations or schedule changes must be arranged no later than 24 hours before the scheduled lesson. Missed lessons or cancellations less than 24 hours before the lesson will result in a \$40 fee. You may forfeit an unused prepaid drive instead of the fee. Showing up for a lesson without a valid license or permit will result in a missed drive fee.

Cancellation of any or part of the BTW course will also result in a \$40 fee.

BTW Courses must be completed within thirteen months from enrollment, subject to availability.

Students will wear appropriate clothing and footwear for lessons. Beach wear and/or flip flops are not suitable. Closed toe and back footwear are essential for safety reasons

If you arrive late for a lesson, or additional travel time is required to rectify clothing/footwear issues, the length of your lesson will be reduced accordingly.
