Enrollment: Please call the school before enrolling to check instructor's availability.

All lessons and lesson packages must be prepaid in full. We take most major credit and debit cards.

All lessons must be used within 13 months of enrolling, subject to availability.

Requirement: You must have a valid FL permit or current license from another state or country on your person for all lessons. You are not permitted to drive without one.

Cancellation: Cancellation of a portion of a prepaid lesson package will result in a \$25 processing fee, and pricing will revert to the pricing available for the number of lessons actually completed.

Any cancellations or schedule changes must be arranged no later than 24 hours before the scheduled lesson. Missed lessons or cancellations less than 24 hours before the lesson will result in a \$40 fee. You may forfeit an unused prepaid drive instead of the fee. Showing up for a lesson without a valid license or permit will result in a missed drive fee.

Reschedule: Rescheduling of a prepaid scheduled lesson can result in a charge up to \$50 at the discretion of the school management.

Refunds: A \$20 processing fee is charged for refunds.

Excess Mileage Fee: A discretionary excess mileage fee could be applicable as determined by the school management.

We offer lessons 7 days per week, at different times during the day. Availability varies according to instructor schedules, however we will work with you to schedule the most convenient times. We frequently schedule with different instructors, please let us know if you prefer to work with the same Instructor.

Every individual is different, and people learn at different speeds. Your Instructor will conduct a skills assessment during your first lesson, and he/she will be able to estimate the number of lessons needed at that time.

Students will wear appropriate clothing and footwear for lessons. Beach wear and/or flip flops are not suitable. Closed toe and back footwear are essential for safety reasons.

If you arrive late for a lesson, or additional travel time is required to rectify clothing/footwear issues, the length of your lesson will be reduced accordingly.
